Metro (London) London Buses route 524 is a Transport for London contracted bus route in London, England operating between East Cross Keys and Cambridge Heath, via Turnpike Lane and Little Britain. History In October 1967, the route was designated as route 44 by TFL, with the new route connecting the newly rebuilt East Cross Keys depot with the expanding Upper Shirley bus station and the former Bentley garage on what was then the Great Eastern Main Line, now part of the Central line. In August 2004, a new depot was built in East Cross Keys, which was opened on 27 February 2005. The new depot also serves as the headquarters for the Central line's Clapham Depot. As a result of this, route 44 was scheduled to be withdrawn. However, as part of an experiment with renumbering many of the TFL bus routes, route 44 was not retired but renumbered 524, becoming part of the new London Buses 524. The route was extended to Nocturnum on 1 December 2004 by eliminating the Bedford Loop service (16, 16A, A16A, 16B, 48). In the London Travel Plan 2005, it was stated that the bus service will be withdrawn when there are fewer than six buses per hour on Turnpike Lane. By October 2005, this occurred, and the service was
